

Pray the Holy Rosary

Note: The Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God, falls on a Monday this year. The obligation to attend Holy Mass is not required; however, attendance is recommended.



Epiphany Water. At this, the Feast of the Epiphany, Holy Church supplies the faithful with a great gift in the form of a solemn blessing of holy water that is afterwards referred to as Epiphany Water. This form of Holy Water is a powerful sacramental for souls and a great weapon in thwarting the power of Satan and the fallen angels. The ceremonial for the blessing of Epiphany Water will be held at 6:30 pm on January 5th.

There is a tradition to use the water and the chalk that are blessed during the beautiful ceremony to bless your home. For this, your family gathers to ask God's blessing on your home and on those who live in or visit the home. The blessing is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in your home, your comings and goings, your conversations, your work and play, your joys and sorrows. During the home blessing, the blessed chalk is used to write above the home's entrance "20 + C + M + B + 24". The letters C, M, B have two meanings. First, they are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. Second, they also abbreviate the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs represent the Cross and 2024 is the year. The text for the home blessing will be provided after the Blessing of the Epiphany Water. For those of you who are unable to attend the ceremonial blessing, extra Epiphany Water and chalk will be available at the Rectory Office.

800th Anniversary of Nativity Scene. Plenary Indulgence. If you plan on visiting a church Nativity scene, you can receive the plenary indulgence from December 8th (the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception) through February 2, (the Feast of the Presentation). The Vatican approved that the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence by praying before a Nativity scene at a church entrusted to the care of the Franciscans. In the Arlington Diocese, you may visit St. Francis of Assisi in Triangle or St. Joseph in Herndon which are both staffed by Franciscans. Another option nearby is the Franciscan Monastery in Washington, D. C. The usual conditions (going to confession and receiving Holy Communion) also apply.

PARISH SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION AND SERVICES

Baptisms - Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sundays at 12:30 pm. Please contact the office at least one month in advance. Parents must be registered members of the parish and first time parents must attend a one session pre-Baptismal class, usually held on the second Saturday of the month at 10:00 a.m. Parents are encouraged to attend this class before the birth of their child; please call to register. The Godparent(s) must provide a Sponsor Certificate from their parish before the Baptism.

Sponsor Certificates - These are Parish testimonies to the fact you are a practicing Catholic in the parish and are issued to those wishing to be a Godparent or sponsor for a Confirmation candidate. You must be registered in the parish and first time Godparents must attend a class before a certificate will be issued.

Sacrament of Matrimony - Contact the office at least 6 months before your desired wedding date. Marriage Preparation is required by Church Law to enable a couple to fully understand the holiness and obligations of the Sacrament. Note that living together before marriage is sinful and harmful to future marriage. Couples who are living together will be asked to live separately during the marriage preparation time.

Religious Education (CCD) - All children not attending a Catholic School who are in the first grade and up should be enrolled in the Parish Religious Education Program. Call the Religious Education Office at (703) 971-8541 for details or email religiousued@stlawrencealex.org

R.C.I.A. - The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are instructed in the Doctrine of the Church and are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. Parish Registration - Prior to receiving particular services from the parish, one must be registered. You may register on the parish website or pick up a registration form at the rectory or in the vestibule of the Church.

Prayers/Visits for Ill or Homebound - If you are ill and would like to be placed on the prayer list or have Holy Communion brought to the home, or if you need to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact the rectory to make arrangements.
