MEMORIALIZE A LOST CHILD. Within our Fr McAfee Memorial Garden, there is a small area surrounded by a circle of red roses, the symbol of life and the Right to Life. Designed by our Knights of Columbus Council 9407, this **Memorial Garden for Unborn Children** honors the memory of all souls lost to abortion, miscarriage and still birth. The Garden provides a pageoful place of prover for an end

miscarriage, and still-birth. The Garden provides a peaceful place of prayer for an end to abortion, for all little ones lost prior to birth, and for those seeking hope and healing



due to their loss. We are updating this Garden with the addition of new statues and memorial stones you can purchase anonymously that are engraved with names of children lost during pregnancy or due to abortion.

Arrangements have been made with *Engraved-rock.com* in Washington state to take orders for personalized memorial stones to be included in this Garden. There are two options for ordering:

Signature Rock: 3"-5" for \$40, suitable for 1-3 words (e.g.: name + date + graphic)

Small Rock: 7"-11" for \$90, accommodating a brief inscription of up to 8-10 words

All stones are natural and engraved to last many years. In addition to selecting the size, you will choose the font, wording, and graphics (Cross, heart, angel, rose, etc) to design your memorial. Your final design will be sent to you and the Pastor for approval before the stone is engraved (without any personal information attached to the proof sent to the pastor). The memorial stone will then be completed and shipped with others directly to St. Lawrence Church for installation in the Garden. Of course, you are free to order a second stone shipped to your home, if desired.

Your confidentiality is important! Identifying information will not be shared with the Pastor or other church staff in any part of the ordering, approval or shipping process. However, all memorial stones are subject to approval before being included in the Garden (as noted above). The initial ordering window is open now through May 31. To purchase a memorial stone through Engraved-rock.com:



DONATE CHILDREN'S CLOTHING

Koinonia continues to accept new and gently-used children's Spring/Summer clothing. Especially needed are girls' and boys' clothing sizes 4-6. Some parishioners have enjoyed buying clothing from Walmart or thrift stores to donate to Koinonia. You may drop-off donations at Koinonia (6037 Franconia Rd; M, T, W, F 9am-12:30pm, Thur 9am-4pm, and 2nd Sat of month only 9am-12:30pm) OR drop off clothing at St. Lawrence in the Narthex bin located in the back of the church.

Book Rack: Summer reading for youth is available on the parish book rack, in the popular graphic novel format. Titles include *The Truth is Out There: Brendan & Erc in Exile* and *The Big Picture* both by "Amadeus", the pen name of a contemplative priest with ties to St. Lawrence! Also in graphic novel format are *The Saints Chronicles Books 1-6* from Sophia Press. Book #1 contains stories of Saints Patrick, Jerome Emiliani, Elizabeth Ann Seton, Henry Morse, and Joan of Arc. On the rack you will also find \$1 booklets from the KofC and Catholic Information Service on a wide range of topics including: The Early Church, Is There a God?, The Eucharist, The Lord's Prayer, and Mary.

PARISH SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION AND SERVICES

Baptisms - Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sundays at 1:45 pm. Please contact the office at least one month in advance. Parents must be registered members of the parish and first time parents must attend a one session pre-Baptismal class, usually held on the second Saturday of the month at 10:00 a.m. Parents are encouraged to attend this class before the birth of their child; please call to register. The Godparent(s) must provide a Sponsor Certificate from their parish before the Baptism. Baptisms in the Extraordinary Form may be requested by calling the parish office.

Sponsor Certificates - These are Parish testimonies to the fact you are a practicing Catholic in the parish and are issued to those wishing to be a Godparent or sponsor for a Confirmation candidate. You must be registered in the parish and first time Godparents must attend a class before a certificate will be issued.

Sacrament of Matrimony - Contact the office at least 6 months before your desired wedding date. Marriage Preparation is required by Church Law to enable a couple to fully understand the holiness and obligations of the Sacrament. Note that living together before marriage is sinful and harmful to future marriage. Couples who are living together will be asked to live separately during the marriage preparation time.

Religious Education (CCD) - All children not attending a Catholic School who are in the first grade and up should be enrolled in the Parish Religious Education Program. Call the Religious Education Office at (703) 971 -8541 for details or email religioused@stlawrencealex.org

R.C.I.A. - The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are instructed in the Doctrine of the Church and are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. Parish Registration - Prior to receiving particular services from the parish, one must be registered. You may register on the parish website or pick up a registration form at the rectory or in the vestibule of the Church. **Prayers/Visits for III or Homebound** - If you are ill and would like to be placed on the prayer list or have Holy Communion brought to the home, or if you need to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact the rectory to make arrangements.
