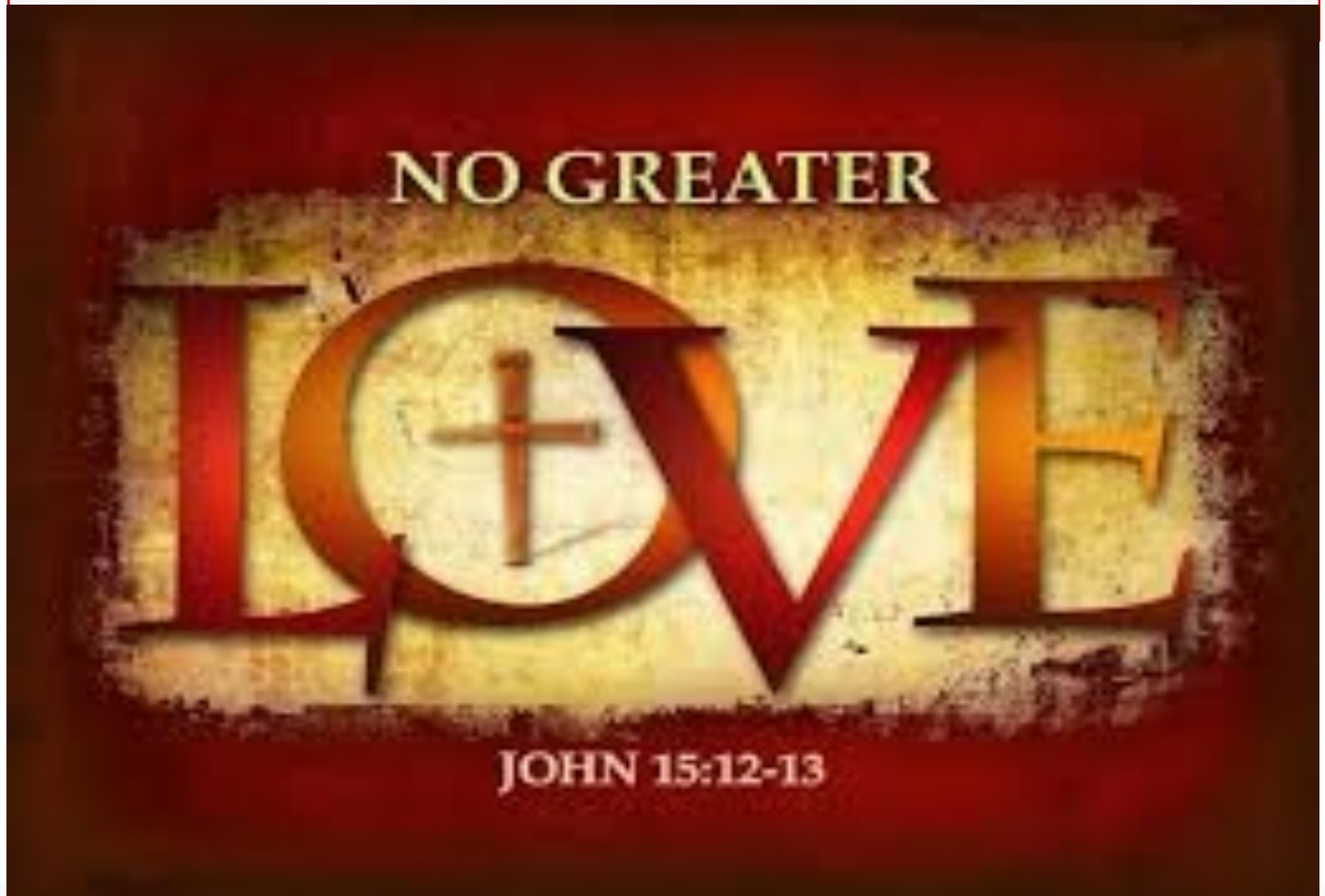

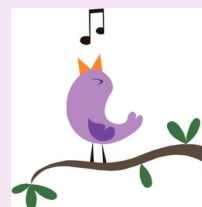

**Offertory Report.** We thank you for meeting your obligation as Catholics to support your church. (Such support meets one of the 5 Precepts of Holy Mother Church.) We wish all parishioners to be comfortable in how they give, but we primarily encourage the use of Faith Direct Electronic giving (see [www.faithdirect.net](http://www.faithdirect.net)) which is the least costly to administrate (more donated dollars go to the poor, charity and other liturgical/sacramental expenses). Of course, the use of envelopes is still a great tradition--and giving in either of these ways, or as many do in cash, sets a great example for your children and those around you who may not give yet; even with Faith Direct you receive cards you can drop in the collection basket to show your support for your Parish and to be an example to others. We hope this information will help you understand better the finances of your parish.

## Baby Cradle Baby Items Needed

The MaRiH Center serves pregnant women and their children, to give options especially for women in crisis. Donations such as those listed below can be left in the cradle near the entrance of the Narthex. Our volunteers make weekly pick ups and deliver the donated items to MaRiH Center:



- Baby clothes up to size 2T
- Baby equipment especially non-expired car seats and strollers that collapse easily
- Maternity and nursing clothes
- Formula, baby food, and diapers (except Walmart Parent's Choice due to chemical smell)
- Other items, such as shoes, bottles, diaper bags, toys, books, stuffed animals, and bedding
- Baby wipes are in short supply.

**LAST CHANCE TO SIGN UP!!  
CPR, AED, and First Aid  
Lifesaving Training at St. Lawrence**

St. Lawrence Catholic Church has purchased and installed AEDs (automated external defibrillators) in each of the Church buildings. These portable medical cardiac devices are used in conjunction with CPR to save the lives of heart attack victims. Importantly, these AED units are only lifesaving devices if they are used by people trained in CPR and the use of AEDs.

**You too can be a life saver!** Our parish is providing First Aid, CPR, and AED certification training. These courses normally cost between \$140 and \$200 per student, but we have negotiated a special rate based on number of registrants. The class date is **Saturday, June 11**. **Faith Direct Electronic Giving:** We encourage the use of Faith Direct for our Parishioners. The option to make your contributions to the parish electronically adds convenience and consistency to your contribution, and saves the cost of mailing envelopes -- so your Church donations goes toward pastoral needs vice administrative costs. In order to show your support, especially as an example to your children and others, Faith Direct provides cards you can place in the baskets passed in Church. **PARISH SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION AND SERVICES**

**Baptisms** - Baptisms are held the 1st and 3rd Sundays at 1:45 pm. Please contact the office at least one month in advance. Parents must be registered members of the parish and first time parents must attend a one session pre-Baptismal class, usually held on the second Saturday of the month at 10:00 a.m. Parents are encouraged to attend this class before the birth of their child; please call to register. The Godparent(s) must provide a Sponsor Certificate from their parish before the Baptism. Baptisms in the Extraordinary Form may be requested by calling the parish office.

**Sponsor Certificates** - These are Parish testimonies to the fact you are a practicing Catholic in the parish and are issued to those wishing to be a Godparent or sponsor for a Confirmation candidate. You must be registered in the parish and first time Godparents must attend a class before a certificate will be issued.

**Sacrament of Matrimony** - Contact the office at least 6 months before your desired wedding date. Marriage Preparation is required by Church Law to enable a couple to fully understand the holiness and obligations of the Sacrament. Note that living together before marriage is sinful and harmful to future marriage. Couples who are living together will be asked to live separately during the marriage preparation time.

**Religious Education (CCD)** - All children not attending a Catholic School who are in the first grade and up should be enrolled in the Parish Religious Education Program. Call the Religious Education Office at (703) 971-8541 for details or email [religioused@stlawrencealex.org](mailto:religioused@stlawrencealex.org)

**R.C.I.A.** - The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are instructed in the Doctrine of the Church and are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. **Parish Registration** - Prior to receiving particular services from the parish, one must be registered. You may register on the parish website or pick up a registration form at the rectory or in the vestibule of the Church.

**Prayers/Visits for Ill or Homebound** - If you are ill and would like to be placed on the prayer list or have Holy Communion brought to the home, or if you need to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact the rectory to make arrangements.

**Weekend Discernment Retreat for Women** - Could Christ be calling you to the religious life? Take a step to find out. The annual diocesan discernment retreat for single women who feel called to a religious vocation is Friday-Sunday, June 17-19. The Capuchin Sisters of Nazareth will lead the retreat this year, and the theme is "Heart to Heart: Love the Lord with all your heart, soul and strength" (Deut. 6:5). It will also include tools to aid your prayer and discernment, as well as opportunities for prayer, confession, spiritual direction, and Q&A with the sisters.
