Father Gripshover's Father, Dr. Ronald J. Gripshover, Sr. is in this week's Prayers of the Faithful at Holy Mass. Your pastor wants to thank you for your kindness and prayers and wanted to let you know the following: "My father is suffering from a serious lung condition called interstitial fibrosis. This disorder is a progressive lung condition that causes scarring in the lung tissue, which, in turn, inhibits the lung's mission to oxygenate the blood. This then causes him to have shortness of breath, low blood oxygen levels, and low energy levels. Currently, he cannot be prescribed oxygen until insurance-required tests are run, which are scheduled in about two weeks."

- Baby clothes up to size 2T
- Baby equipment especially nonexpired car seats and strollers that collapse easily
 - Maternity and nursing clothes
- Formula, baby food, and diapers (except Walmart Parent's Choice due to chemical smell)
- Other items, such as shoes, bottles, diaper bags, toys, books, stuffed animals, and bedding
 - Baby wipes are in short supply.

LENTEN OBSERVANCE - FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Remember, on GOOD FRIDAY:

- -If you are 14 or older, you must abstain from meat.
- -If you are 18-60 Years old, you must Fast.

On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain one's strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. Medications, taken according to need, do not break the fast.

Fasting, almsgiving and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and Catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for sacramental initiation into the Church or the renewal of our baptismal promises and participation in the Mysteries of Easter.

PRACTICAL ALMSGIVING SHARE SUNDAY

Our next Share Sunday is Easter Weekend, **April 16-17.** There is no "drive-thru drop-off" option this month. However Koinonia still needs our assistance! If more convenient, non**perishable** items may be left in the Narthex donation bin anytime church is open OR dropped off directly at Koinonia, 6037 Franconia Rd, MTWF 9-12:30, Thu 9-4, and second Sat only 9-12:30. Koinonia is closed on Good Friday. Most needed items: all-purpose cleaners, laundry detergent, cereal, jelly/jam, juice, coffee (instant and regular), sugar, canned salmon and sardines, beef stew, canned pasta (eg Chef Boyardee), ketchup, mayo, salad dressing, pancake mix, spaghetti sauce, gravy (no glass), automatic dishwasher detergent, men's and women's deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, bath soap, toilet paper, tissues, razors and shaving cream, baby diapers size 6, and gift cards (Aldi, Giant, Lidl, Dollar Tree).
